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### ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER FOR RALEY'S DOCK REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID#5A57CR00143A1), YOLO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 18 October 2018 request for an amendment of the Raley's Dock Replacement Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (5A57CR00143). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 18 November 2016. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

#### AMENDMENT:

This amendment removes the water quality monitoring requirement for settleable material as requested by the City of West Sacramento. The remaining water quality monitoring requirements provide sufficient characterization of the discharge(s) to evaluate impact to water quality. The Certification is amended as shown in underline/strikeout format below:

#### C. Water Quality Monitoring

##### 1. In-Water Work or Diversions:

During planned work in water any discharge(s) to waters of the state shall conform to the following water quality standards:

- e. ~~Activities shall not cause settleable matter to exceed 0.1 mL/L in surface waters as measured in surface waters within 300 feet downstream of the Project.~~
