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***ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT §401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, GOODWIN CANYON SALMONID SPAWNING GRAVEL REPLENISHMENT PROJECT (WDID#5B55CR00066A1), TUOLUMNE COUNTY***

This Order responds to the 10 July 2015 request for an amendment of the Goodwin Canyon Salmonid Spawning Gravel Replenishment (Project) Project § 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B55CR00066). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 25 August 2011. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

**AMENDMENT:**

This amendment is to make the project implementation timeframe consistent with the National Marine Fisheries Service and the United States Army Corps of Engineers requirements, and to ensure the least amount of turbidity generated from the Project.

The National Marine Fisheries Service allows in-water work to be conducted from 30 June through 1 September. In addition, the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2004-00280) authorizes in-water construction activities to continue until 26 August 2016.

The Project Information Sheet is amended as shown in underline/strikeout format below:

**Approximate Timeframe of Project Implementation:** ~~29 August 2011 to 9 September 2011~~ 30 June to 1 September. In-water work is not allowed after 26 August 2016

The Additional Technical Certification Conditions are amended as shown in the underline/strikeout format below:

18. The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation shall use clean/washed gravel which will cause little or no siltation.
