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ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT § 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, GOODWIN CANYON SALMONID SPAWNING GRAVEL REPLENISHMENT PROJECT (WDID#5B55CR00066), TUOLUMNE COUNTY

This Order responds to the 29 April 2016 request for an amendment of the Goodwin Canyon Salmonid Spawning Gravel Replenishment Project § 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B55CR00066). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 25 August 2011. The original Certification was amended on 3 August 2015 (WDID#5B55CR00066A1). The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The United States Bureau of Reclamation is requesting a time extension through 26 August 2018. A time extension was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers on 20 April 2016. The United States Bureau of Reclamation has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2004-00280) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 26 August 2018.

This amendment is to make the Project implementation timeframe consistent with the National Marine Fisheries Service and the United States Army Corps of Engineers requirements.
