### **NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION OF 2012 NATIONWIDE PERMITS, WELLS 12kV INFRASTRUCTURE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, WDID#5C54CR00091, TULARE COUNTY**

Southern California Edison notified the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board of its intent to replace an existing deteriorated pole within a potentially jurisdictional drainage feature, with an in-kind composite pole. The Project area includes a 25-foot-radius temporary construction work area around the pole required for foot traffic and equipment staging for pole removal and replacement. Project implementation will result in a maximum temporary disturbance of 0.002 acre (15 linear feet) of potential non-wetland waters of the U.S. The Project is located at Latitude 36.366144 °, Longitude -119.1386 °. The activity is authorized by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Clean Water Act Section 404 Nationwide Permit No. 12- Utility Line Activities.

Activities authorized by Nationwide Permit No. 12 have been granted certification by the State Water Resources Control Board Executive Director, subject to the Conditions and the Notification Requirements given in the General Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers 2012 Nationwide Permits (General Certification) (enclosed). You have met the notification requirements, and the Project meets the conditions of the General Certification and you may proceed with the Project in accordance with the terms and conditions of the General Certification.

Any person aggrieved by this action may petition the State Water Resources Control Board to review the action in accordance with California Water Code § 13320 and California Code of Regulations, title 23, § 2050 and following. The State Water Resources Control Board must receive the petition by 5:00 p.m., 30 days after the date of this action, except that if the thirtieth day following the date of this action falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or state holiday, the petition must be received by the State Water Resources Control Board by 5:00 p.m. on the next business day.
