NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY: STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 GENERAL WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION. SB17001GN, OF THE 2017 NATIONWIDE PERMITS (NWP NO. 12) FOR OLD DURHAM WOOD COMPANY (APPLICANT), OLD DURHAM WOOD STORMWATER PIPELINE PROJECT (PROJECT), 1156 OROVILLE-CHICO HIGHWAY, BUTTE COUNTY, WDID NO. 5A04CR00308

This letter is to certify work to install a pipeline to convey industrial stormwater runoff from the Old Durham Wood facility to the historical rice fields east of the site in Butte County under the State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification of 2017 Nationwide Permits, SB17001GN.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed Project's primary goal is to install a 15-inch pipeline to convey industrial stormwater runoff from the Old Durham Wood facility to the historical rice fields east of the site. The rice fields will act as a bio filter to filter stormwater from the site prior to discharge to Hamlin Slough. The pipeline will be installed using trenching methods and will pass through Hamlin Slough; the pipeline route has been selected to avoid all vernal pools in the Project area.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of Certification No. SB17001GN may expose Old Durham Wood Company to enforcement action pursuant to the Clean Water Act and California Water Code.
