NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER ORDER NO. 2023-0058-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL TO WATERS OF THE STATE FROM EMERGENCY REPAIR AND PROTECTION ACTIVITIES, CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS), STATE ROUTE 193 EMERGENCY CULVERT REPAIR PROJECT (WDID#5A09CR00253), EL DORADO COUNTY

On 31 October 2025, Caltrans (Permittee) filed a notification requesting coverage under the 13 July 2023 State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Dredged or Fill Material to Waters of the State from Emergency Repair and Protection Activities (General Dredge or Fill WDR).

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has reviewed the enrollment materials and finds the State Route 193 Emergency Culvert Repair Project (Project) meets the requirements of, and is hereby enrolled under, Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ. The Permittee may proceed with the Project in accordance with the Order.

Failure to comply with Order No. 2023-0058-DWQ constitutes a violation of the California Water Code and may result in enforcement action or termination of enrollment under the General Dredge or Fill WDR.

The Project is being conducted in accordance with the requirements contained in this Notice of Applicability and General Dredge or Fill WDR. The Project is described in the notification form requesting coverage under the General Dredge or Fill WDR, dated

31 October 2025, and supplementary information (Application Package). Coverage under the General Dredge or Fill WDR is no longer valid if the Project (as described) is modified.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The State Route 193 Emergency Culvert Repair (Project) consists of emergency repair on State Route 193 at post mile (PM) 8.82 in El Dorado County. Caltrans District 03 Maintenance discovered two culverts which have failed, creating dangerous road conditions. Permanent repair required includes the removal and replacement of two existing corrugated metal pipe culverts with reinforced concrete pipe culverts in an unnamed intermittent drainage. Existing headwalls will be rebuilt.

The Project will temporarily impact 0.07 acre/92 linear feet of waters of the United States.

The Project was completed in November 2025.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

An application fee of \$4,212.00 was received on 16 March 2026.

The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), and was calculated as category E - Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
