ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; COUNTY OF GLENN, WILSON CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A11CR00032A2), GLENN COUNTY

This Order responds to the 26 March 2026 request for an amendment to the County of Glenn County, Wilson Creek Bridge Replacement Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification. The original Water Quality Certification (certification) was issued on 20 June 2019 (WDID No. 5A11CR00032), and an amendment to extend the expiration date was issued on 13 June 2024 (WDID No. 5A11CR00032A1). The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification and previously approved amendment are therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification, along with its prior amendments.

AMENDMENT:

The County of Glenn (hereinafter Permittee) is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order and previously approved amendment to extend the expiration date of 14 March 2026 to 15 March 2027.
