### **ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; GLENN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY, WALKER CREEK BRIDGE (11C-0267) REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A11CR00045A2), GLENN COUNTY**

This Order responds to the 26 March 2026 request for an amendment to the Glenn County Public Works Agency, Walker Creek Bridge (11C-0267) Replacement Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification. The original Water Quality Certification (certification) was issued on 5 May 2020 (WDID No. 5A11CR00045), and an amendment to extend the original expiration date was issued on 7 February 2025 (WDID No. 5A11CR00045A1). The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification and previously approved amendment are therefore amended as described below.
