### **ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF ROSEVILLE, DRY CREEK GREENWAY EAST TRAIL PROJECT (WDID#5A31CR00583A1), PLACER COUNTY**

This Order responds to the 16 September 2025 request for an amendment of the Dry Creek Greenway East Trail Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A31CR00583). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 22 November 2022. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below.

#### **AMENDMENT:**

The City of Roseville (Permittee) is requesting a change in project impacts and description, as well as a request for an expiration time extension. The Permittee and consultants assessed design options and the environmental and regulatory constraints of repairing the eroding slope that is encroaching into the trail alignment. Based on this evaluation, a new slope protection element was added to the Project, consisting of Longitudinal Peaked Stone Toe Protection (LPSTP) and Rock Slope Protection (RSP) over an area approximately 100 feet in length.

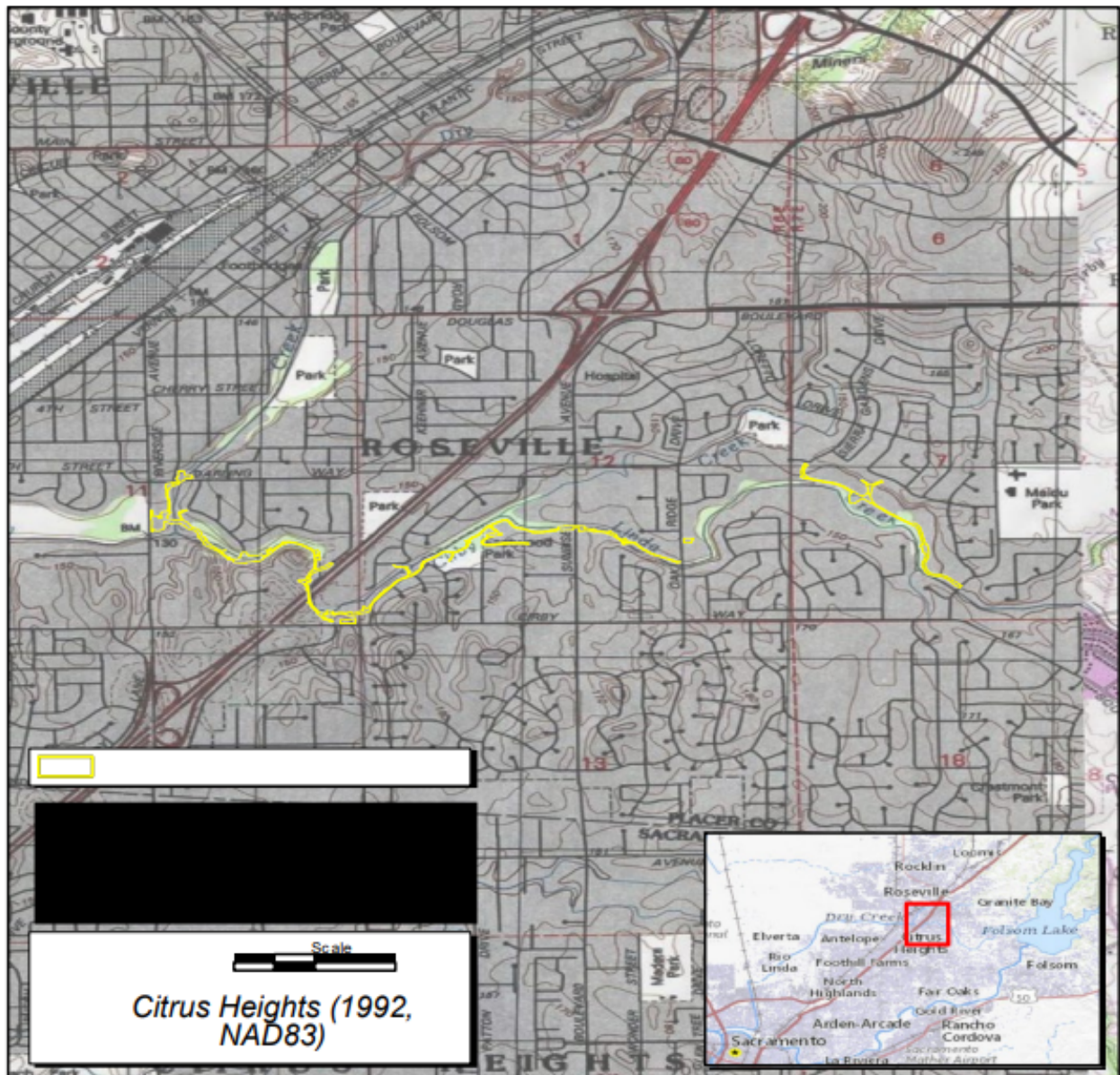




Figure 2– Site Map

Temporary and permanent impacts cover an area of approximately 0.04 acre, as shown in Figure 2. The Permittee is working with the construction contractor to allow the work to be completed during the allowable in-water work window (i.e., prior to October 15), so the threat to bank stability can be addressed prior to the approaching rainy season. Construction of the new slope protection element would result in minor additional impacts to Waters of the State, consisting of 0.03 acre of permanent impact and 0.011 acre of temporary impact below the ordinary high water mark (OHWM) of Linda Creek.

The Permittee has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2021-00087) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 21 November 2027. The amendment extends the expiration date of the Certification to 21 November 2027.

Figure 1- Location Map
