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ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, BOND ROAD UPSIZING PROJECT (WDID#5A34CR00614A2), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 24 July 2023 request for an amendment of the Bond Road Upsizing (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A34CR00614). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 8 June 2015. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Elk Grove is requesting a time extension through 14 May 2026. The date change will allow the City of Elk Grove to proceed with the Project described in the original Certification. A time extension was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers on 12 July 2023. The City of Elk Grove has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2015-00135) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 14 May 2026.

The Certification is amended to reflect an expiration date of 14 May 2026.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$200.00 for the original Certification were received on 31 December 2014. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), as was calculated as category E – Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
