ORDER AMENDING WATER QUALITY ORDER NO. R5-2020-0048, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GRANT LINE CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATE PRODUCTION AND RECYCLING FACILITY PROJECT; VULCAN MATERIAL COMPANY, (WDID#5A34CR00882A1), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 11 June 2025 request for an amendment of Water Quality Order No. R5-2024-0017, Waste Discharge Requirements for the Grant Line Construction Aggregate Production and Recycling Facility Project (WDID#5A31CR00534). The original Order was adopted on 19 April 2024. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Order is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Order.

#### AMENDMENT:

The Waste Discharge Requirements are amended to include impacts to 2.64 acres of additional wetlands that can no longer be avoided to complete the Project. The wetlands will be permanently filled to accommodate parking and storage. The proposed truck parking and storage area would consist of permeable loose rock and include a bioretention area for stormwater infiltration. Mitigation bank credits will be purchased to compensate for additional impacts. An updated impact map is included as an attachment.

Section J.3 of the Requirements is amended as shown below:

## 3. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

- **a.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 3.01 acre of wetland habitat by purchasing 3.01 vernal pool creation credits from Elsie Gridley Mitigation Bank.
- **b.** Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent physical loss of area is summarized in Table 3. [Establishment (Est.), Reestablishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
