ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; NORTH STATE GROCERY, INC., HOLIDAY MARKET PLACE PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A45CR00607A1), SHASTA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 18 October 2021 request for an amendment of the Holiday Market Place Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order (WDID No. 5A45CR00607). The original Water Quality Certification and Order (Certification) was issued on 8 October 2021. The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

North State Grocery, Inc. is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to alter the compensatory mitigation proposal to purchase an additional 0.052 acres of wetland establishment credits rather than 0.052 acres of pond establishment credits due to availability of credit types at Stillwater Plains Mitigation bank.

Therefore, Section XIV.K.2.b and Table 3; and Attachment B, Table 4 of the Certification are amended in underline format:

K. Compensatory Mitigation for Permanent Impacts:

2. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

- a. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.33 acre of stream channel by purchasing 0.495 acre of stream channel establishment credits from Stillwater Plains Mitigation Bank.

- b. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.035 acre of pond by purchasing 0.052 acre of wetland establishment credits from Stillwater Plains Mitigation Bank.
- c. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.057 acre of wetland by purchasing 0.085 acre of wetland establishment credits from Stillwater Plains Mitigation Bank.
- d. Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent physical loss of area is summarized in Table 3. [Establishment (Est.), Re-establishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
