NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER ORDER NO. 2004-0004-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DREDGED OR FILL DISCHARGES TO WATERS DEEMED BY THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO BE OUTSIDE OF FEDERAL JURISDICTION, VACA VALLEY LOGISTICS CENTER PROJECT (WDID#5A48CR00191), SOLANO COUNTY

On 25 October 2021, LDK Ventures submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) to enroll under and comply with State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Order No. 2004-0004-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Dredged or Fill Discharges to Waters Deemed by the United States. Army Corps of Engineers to be Outside of Federal Jurisdiction.

The Central Valley Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has reviewed your enrollment materials and finds the Vaca Valley Logistics Center Project (Project) meets the requirements of, and is hereby enrolled under, Order No. 2004-0004-DWQ. You may proceed with your Project in accordance with the Order.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The approximately 27-acre Project consists of mass grading to prepare for constructing warehouse distribution buildings with associated parking, landscaping, and installing two on-site utilities in the City of Vacaville's Golden Hills Business Park Policy Plan Area.

Project elements that affect aquatic resources include permanently filling 0.083 acre of Mark Bradford, CHAIR | PATRICK PULUPA, Esq., Executive officer

non-jurisdictional, seasonal wetland during grading activities.

PROJECT LOCATION:

The Project is located at 2010 Cessna Drive in Vacaville near Vaca Valley Parkway. The approximate center of the Project area is located at latitude 38.38895° and longitude -121.96279°.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

July 2022 through October 2027

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

2,066.00 was received on 28 June 2022. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3) and was calculated as category E - Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
