ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER FOR CALTRANS, SACRAMENTO RIVER BRIDGE SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A52CR00189A1), TEHAMA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 12 November 2019 request for an amendment of the Sacramento River Bridge Seismic Retrofit Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order (WDID No. 5A52CR00189). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 5 August 2019. The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

Caltrans is requesting clarification of the required compensatory mitigation in the Section 401 Water Quality Certification to specify the particular service area for which resource credits are required to be purchased. Therefore, Section XII.K.2.a of the Water Quality Certification is amended as shown below.

XII.K.2.a. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

- a. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.03 acre of stream channel by purchasing 0.06 aquatic resource credits from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation's (NFWF) Sacramento District California In-Lieu Fee Program for the Northwest Sacramento River Watershed Service Area.
