ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF ANTIOCH, WEST ANTIOCH CREEK SILT REMOVAL PROJECT (WDID#5B07CR00249A1), CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

This Order responds to the 3 May 2023 request for an amendment of the West Antioch Creek Silt Removal Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B07CR00249). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 16 November 2022. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Antioch is requesting a change to temporary impacts due to the addition of a third cofferdam. Additionally, the two cofferdams and filter bags initially proposed had the incorrect dimensions; therefore, the overall temporary impacts due to dewatering have not increased even though a third cofferdam was added.

The Certification is amended to replace Figures 2 and 3 in Attachment A of the Certification with Figure 1 and 2 below, respectively, to demonstrate the additional cofferdam and impacts.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$17,020.00 for the original Certification were received on 19 August 2022 and 11 October 2022. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), as was calculated as category A - Fill & Excavation Discharges (fee code 84) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
