**RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ,
STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO
LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC
COMPANY, NATURAL GAS PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT R-502 EXCAVATION
DEWATERING DISCHARGE, SUTTER COUNTY**

On 23 December 2015, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ-0145) to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E). The Notice of Applicability was for temporary discharges of dewatering during Pipeline Replacement Project R-502 in Sutter County.

Your 24 May 2016 email and Notice of Termination state that the project has been completed and you wish to terminate coverage under the General WDRs. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ is hereby rescinded.
