RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, MOUNTAIN HOUSE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 22 November 2019, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the Mountain House Community Services District for a dewatering project.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination, dated 24 February 2022, stating that the project is complete and discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0204 is hereby rescinded.
