NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ-0205; ASPHALT TERMINALS, LLC; BAKERSFIELD TERMINAL – TANK 1101 HYDROSTATIC TEST; KERN COUNTY

On 4 December 2019, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued Asphalt Terminals, LLC (or Discharger) a Notice of Applicability (NOA) for coverage under Water Quality Order 2003-0003-DWQ, *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order) for the discharge of hydrostatic test water from integrity testing of Tank 1101 to an on-site evaporation pond.

The discharge was completed on 21 January 2020, and the Discharger submitted a Notice of Termination (NOT) on 28 January 2020 to terminate coverage of the above described discharge under the General Order, enrollee number 2003-0003-DWQ-0205. According to the Discharger, approximately 45,000 gallons of hydrostatic test water was discharged to the evaporation pond over a two day period. According to the NOT, hydrostatic testing of Tank 1101 is complete, and no further discharge is expected. Therefore, coverage under the General Order is terminated.
