
Notice of Termination for General Order No. R5-2008-0149-008, ARCO Service Station No. 6019 and ConocoPhillips 76 Service Station No. 6027, 2933 and 2893 65th Street, Sacramento, Sacramento County

On 18 July 2011, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability under Order No. R5-2008-0149, *In-Situ Groundwater Remediation at Sites with Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Compounds, Perchlorate, Pesticides, Semi-Volatile Compounds, Hexavalent Chromium and/or Petroleum Hydrocarbons*. In the Notice of Applicability the project was assigned site-specific Order No. R5-2008-0149-008.

Injection of ozone under the order was never conducted due to declining contaminant trends, and monitored natural attenuation was utilized as the final remedial action.

Your consultant Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (Stantec), requested termination of coverage for the Project on your behalf in a letter dated 2 July 2014, with a subject line of *Request to Rescind WDR Permit*. Therefore, through this letter, General Order No. R5-2008-0149-008 is hereby terminated as of the date of this letter. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
