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
SUBJECT: NOTICE OF TERMINATION FOR GENERAL ORDER NO. R5-2011-0149-033 AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM (MRP) No. R5-2008-0149-0811, SHOEI FOODS, 1900 FEATHER RIVER BLVD., OLIVEHURST, YUBA COUNTY, LUSTIS #580240

On 22 December 2011, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued A Notice of Applicability under Order No. R5-2008-0149, *General Order for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation At Sites With Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Compounds, Perchlorate, Pesticides, Semi-Volatile Compounds, Hexavalent Chromium and/or Petroleum Hydrocarbons*. In the Notice of Applicability, the project was assigned site-specific Order No. R5-2011-0149-033 and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) R5-2008-0149-0811.

Shoei Foods conducted remediation for this project from 9 March 2012 to 25 April 2013, which included the application of in-situ chemical oxidants to the site's subsurface. The remediation project is no longer need to mitigate groundwater contaminants from the former underground tank release.

On 29 April 2013, you requested termination of coverage for the project. Therefore, with an effective date of 29 April 2013 General Order No. R5-2011-0149-033 and MRP R5-2008-0149-0811 are hereby terminated. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
