## GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R5-2008-0081-016 DEWATERING AND OTHER LOW THREAT DISCHARGES TO SURFACE WATERS NPDES NO. CAG995001 (LOW THREAT GENERAL ORDER) for EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT and RANGER PIPELINES, INC. FOLSOM SOUTH CANAL CONNECTION, MIDDLE PIPELINE SEGMENT PROJECT SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 18 March 2009, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability for Low Threat General Order coverage to Ranger Pipelines, Inc. and East Bay Municipal Utility District for the Folsom South Canal Connection, Middle Pipeline Segment Project, in San Joaquin County. The construction dewatering project discharged to Coyote Creek and the Mokelumne River.

Our office received a 1 July 2009 letter from East Bay Municipal Utility District that requested permit termination. Therefore, through this letter, our office is confirming that coverage under Low Threat General Order No. R5-2008-0081-016 is no longer necessary and is terminated, effective 1 July 2009. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
