NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LOW THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2013-0074-037, DRINKING WATER SYSTEM MAINTENANCE DISCHARGES, SACRAMENTO COUNTY

Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) staff has been notified that the California America Water Company (Discharger) has been issued a Notice of Applicability implementing regulatory coverage for all of its potable water distribution facilities, except for the Security Park drinking water system, under the Statewide Drinking Water System Discharge Permit, State Water Board Order 2014-0194-DWQ, with an effective date of 12 October 2015. In addition, the Discharger submitted a Notice of Termination Form dated 31 October 2017 to the Central Valley Water Board requesting termination of coverage for the Security Park drinking water system under the Low threat General Order.

Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage under Low Threat General Order R5-2013-0074-037 (WDID No. 5A34NP00007) is hereby terminated as of 31 October 2017 through this letter. Please note that you must still submit your last quarterly monitoring report required under the Low Threat General Order to the Compliance/Enforcement staff. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
