NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LIMITED THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2016-0076, DREW TUNNEL GROUNDWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM, NEVADA COUNTY

Thank you for submitting the Notice of Termination Form dated 31 August 2017 requesting termination of coverage under the Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076 for the Drew Tunnel Groundwater Treatment System (Project), which indicates the discharge stopped on 17 May 2017.

On 4 August 2014, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability for the Project, which was assigned Limited Threat General Order R5-2013-0073-037 and WDID No. 5A29NP00012. The Second Quarter 2017 Discharge Monitoring Report was submitted on 11 July 2017. Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage is hereby terminated as of 17 May 2017 through this letter.
