NOTICE OF TERMINATION; LIMITED THREAT GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2016-0076-01, DUTCH SLOUGH TIDAL MARSH RESTORATION PROJECT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

Thank you for submitting the Notice of Termination Form dated 18 June 2020 requesting termination of coverage under the Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-01 for the Dutch Slough Tidal Marsh Restoration Project (Project).

On 22 November 2017, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability for the Project, which was assigned Limited Threat General Order R5-2016-0076-023 and Waste Discharger Identification 5B07NP00025. Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage is hereby terminated as of 18 June 2020 through this letter.

Please note that you must still submit your last quarterly monitoring report required under the Limited Threat General Order to the Compliance/Enforcement staff. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
