TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT MAINTENANCE PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLOUS COUNTIES

On 19 January 2018, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the Waiver of Report of Waste Discharger and Waste Discharge Requirements for Specific Types of Discharge within the Central Valley Region (Waiver), Order No. R5-2013-0145, to the Department of Water Resources for discharge to land from sediment removal associated with stilling wells.

Your Notice of Termination, dated 26 July 2019, states that no further discharges from the project will occur and the Department of Water Resources wishes to terminate coverage under the Waiver. Based on that information, coverage under R5-2013-0145-0100 is hereby rescinded.
