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NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY

**WAIVER OF REPORT OF WASTE DISCHARGE AND WASTE DISCHARGE
REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC TYPES OF DISCHARGE
WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION,
COBB AREA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
BRANDING IRON MUTUAL WATER COMPANY WELL AND TREATMENT SITE
LAKE COUNTY**

On 29 June 2018, Cobb Area County Water District (CACWD) submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) to obtain coverage under the *Waiver of Report of Waste Discharge and Waste Discharge Requirements for Specific Types of Discharge within the Central Valley Region*, Order R5-2013-0145 (the Waiver). The submittal contains all the information required to evaluate the applicability of the Waiver; therefore, the NOI is considered complete and the discharge meets the conditions of the Waiver. The discharge is hereby covered under the Waiver, Order R5-2013-0145-0111. Please include this number on all correspondence related to this discharge.

Project Location and Description

CACWD owns and operates the site known as the Branding Iron Well and Treatment Site. The site is located at 9105 State Route 175, Kelseyville in Lake County, as shown on Attachment A, which is attached hereto and is made part of this Notice of Applicability (NOA) by reference. Construction activities at the site will include construction of a treatment building, new well, bridge, and back wash recovery tank, as well as modification of an existing well. CACWD anticipates dewatering activities during the bridge construction. The dewatering period will be limited to a few weeks in the 2019 construction season, between 1 May to 15 October. Encountered groundwater will be discharged on the project site, approximately 0.65 acres comprising of native grasslands and trees, as shown on Attachment A. The estimated daily discharge volume will not exceed 1,200 gallons per day (gpd). No additives or chemicals will be added to the discharged water.

Facility-Specific Requirements

Please review the attached Waiver documents and ensure that the discharge complies with the Conditions of Discharge contained in Attachment A of the Waiver. CACWD is responsible for

compliance with the Waiver and must provide sufficient contractor oversight to ensure compliance and prompt reporting of any noncompliance.

The Water Quality Control Plan for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins, Fourth Edition, revised October 2011 (hereafter Basin Plan), designates beneficial uses, establishes water quality objectives, contains implementation plans and policies for protecting waters of the basin, and incorporates by reference plans and policies adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board. Pursuant to §13263(a) of the California Water Code (CWC), waste discharge requirements must implement the Basin Plan.


