# NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY

WAIVER OF REPORT OF WASTE DISCHARGE AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC TYPES OF DISCHARGE WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION,
PHELAN DEVELOPMENT
HOLLY OFF-SITE
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 8 December 2020, the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District submitted a Notice of Intent to obtain coverage under the Waiver of Report of Waste Discharge and Waste Discharge Requirements for Specific Types of Discharge within the Central Valley Region, Order R5-2018-0085 (the Waiver). The submittal contains all the information required to evaluate the applicability of the Waiver; therefore, the NOI is considered complete and the discharge meets the conditions of the Waiver. The discharge is hereby covered under the Waiver, Order R5-2018-0085-0054. Please include this number on all correspondence related to this discharge.

# **Project Location and Description**

Phelan Development (Discharger) is installing storm drains as part of the S. Holly Road and Arbor Road Improvement Project. Groundwater dewatering wells will be installed and have approximately 3 days of draw down and 6 days to install the storm drains. All extracted groundwater will be discharged to an on-site 30 ac/ft retention basin to infiltrate and evaporate. No off-site discharge is anticipated.

The Water Quality Control Plan for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins, Fifth Edition, revised May 2018, establishes water quality objectives, contains implementation plans and policies for protecting waters of the basin, and incorporates by reference plans and policies adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board. Pursuant to §13263(a) of the California Water Code (CWC), waste discharge requirements must implement the Basin Plan.

# **Facility Specific Requirements**

Please review the attached waiver documents and ensure that the discharge complies with the Conditions of Discharged contained in Attachment A of the waiver. The Discharger is responsible for compliance with the waiver and must provide sufficient oversight to ensure compliance and prompt reporting of any noncompliance.
