Calaveras County Water District is pleased to offer these comments on the
aforementioned tentative permit to be heard at the May 3 & 4, 2007 Board meeting.
Our agency is a water purveyor as well as a wastewater provider in Calaveras County.

The District wishes to express our general support for the permit requirements. We are
a downstream water purveyor and are pleased that only Title 22 recycled water will be
discharged into Angles Creek and that this discharge can take place only when the
stream flow is such to provide a 20 to 1 dilution. The District is confident that these
safeguards are fully protective of the public health of the District's customers in the
Copper Cove service area as well as the aquatic life in the receiving stream and
downstream water bodies.
