**PUBLIC HEARING**

WAIVER OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
for

**CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES  
TISDALE BYPASS SEDIMENT REMOVAL PROJECT  
SUTTER COUNTY**

The Tisdale Bypass is a key flood control facility along the Sacramento River. Sediment deposits have reduced the flow capacity of the bypass reducing the efficiency of the channel to transport flood waters from the Sacramento River to the Sutter Bypass. To restore capacity, the California Department of Water Resources (Discharger) proposes to remove approximately 2,000,000 cubic yards of sediment from the 4.3-mile long bypass channel. Spoils from the project will be discharged to agricultural land immediately north of the bypass for use as buttress soil for the levee and soil stockpile for emergency levee repair. The Discharger has demonstrated that the spoils are not contaminated with pesticides and are chemically similar to the native soils at the discharge site. Staff has determined that the discharge poses little or no threat to water quality if the spoils are discharged under conditions that prevent erosion.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Board
- Discharger – California Department of Water Resources

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **6 April 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **6 April 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **6 April 2007** will not be

accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
