Response to Written Comments for Compost Solutions Inc. and Road 27 Limited
Partnership, Compost Facility
Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements

The following is a response to written comments received from an interested party in response to the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for Compost Solutions Inc. and Road 27 Limited Partnership, Compost Facility, Glenn County. Written comments from the interested party on the tentative requirements were required to be received by the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) by 8 June 2007 in order to receive full consideration. Written comments from the above interested party are summarized below, followed by the response of the Regional Water Board staff.

GLENN COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Comment #1: The California Waste Management Board (CIWMB) does not directly regulate composting facilities. The Environmental Health Department regulates composting facilities as an Agricultural Material Composting Operation under CIWMB regulations. Glenn County Environmental Health requested that Finding No. 6 be changed to correctly reflect the county's oversight of the facility.

Response: Staff changed Finding No. 6 to correctly reflect the county's oversight of the composting facility.
