NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
concerning

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR
CLEAN CLOSURE OF
FOLSOM CORPORATION YARD LANDFILL
CITY OF FOLSOM
CLASS III LANDFILL
SACRAMENTO COUNTY

The City of Folsom owns the Folsom Corporation Yard Landfill, a 4.5 acre closed landfill on Leidesdorff Street in Folsom. The landfill was active from 1974 until 1987, accepting primarily street cleaning wastes and other debris from City projects. The landfill was capped with a low permeability clay cover in 1996. Subsequent groundwater monitoring confirmed impacts to shallow groundwater from the landfill relative to background, including dissolved solids (634 mg/L), and dissolved arsenic (20 µg/L) and iron (14,000 µg/L). The proposed WDRs prescribe requirements for the Discharger's plan to clean close (i.e., excavate and remove) the landfill as a corrective action measure to address these impacts. The WDRs prescribe requirements for project operations, including soil and groundwater cleanup, storm water control, and project financial assurances. The monitoring and reporting program in the WDRs requires semiannual groundwater monitoring and specifies the criteria for demonstrating groundwater cleanup under Title 27. Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the

Board no later than **23 June 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **23 June 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **23 June 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
