**TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:**

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for an existing potato processing facility owned by Bidart Bros., Inc., in Bakersfield, Kern County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 5/6 June 2014 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 15 April 2014**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.


