Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Pacific Gas And Electric Company, Kerckhoff Dam Low Level Outlet Gate Replacement Project are available for public comment, as explained in the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing. The Central Valley Water Board may elect to adopt WDRs that differ from the recommended WDRs and may do so without another public comment period if determined to be consistent with applicable laws and regulations.
