**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO TIME SCHEDULE ORDER NO. R5-2015-0034  
(NPDES NO. CA0079316)**

**PLACER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY SERVICES  
PLACER COUNTY SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1,  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
PLACER COUNTY**

Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger) owns and operates Sewer Maintenance District No. 1 Wastewater Treatment Plant that provides sewerage service to the northern portion of Auburn in Placer County. Treated wastewater is discharged to Rock Creek, a tributary to Dry Creek, the Bear River, and the Sacramento River.

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider amending the Discharger's existing Time Schedule Order R5-2015-0034 to reflect the current schedule for repairing construction flaws in the wastewater transmission lines that will convey the wastewater to the City of Lincoln Wastewater Treatment and Reclamation Facility. In addition, the proposed amended order will extend protection from mandatory minimum penalties to the Discharger for effluent violations of aluminum, ammonia, biological oxygen demand (BOD<sub>5</sub>), chloroform, dibromochloromethane, dichlorobromomethane, nitrate plus nitrite, nitrite, total coliform organisms, and total suspended solids (TSS) until 1 September 2016.

The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
