NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

ADOPTION OF THE FOLLOWING ORDERS:

- 1) NPDES PERMIT RENEWAL (NPDES NO. CA0081434)
- 2) WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, AND
- 3) TIME SCHEDULE ORDER

For

CITY OF GALT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND RECLAMATION FACILITY SACRAMENTO COUNTY

The City of Galt (Discharger) owns and operates the City of Galt Wastewater Treatment Plant and Reclamation Facility (Facility), a publicly owned treatment works (POTW) located at 10059 Twin Cities Road, Galt, California. The Facility provides sewerage service for the City of Galt and surrounding area, serving a population of approximately 24,000. The Facility provides tertiary treatment for up to 3.0 million gallons per day (MGD). Tertiary treated wastewater from the Facility is discharged to Laguna Creek, a water of the United States. Additionally, undisinfected secondary treated wastewater is applied to the Discharger's Agricultural Reuse area during growing seasons in order to irrigate non-food crops.

Discharges from the Facility are currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2010-0099 (NPDES No. CA0081434), issued by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) on 23 September 2010. The Discharger requested separate permits for the land application and discharges to surface water. Two new Orders are proposed to: 1) renew the NPDES permit for discharges to Laguna Creek, and 2) adopt separate Waste Discharge Requirements for reclamation activities.

The proposed NPDES permit renewal includes new or revised effluent limitations for ammonia and zinc. In addition, the effluent limitations for aluminum, carbon tetrachloride, chlorodibromomethane, copper, cyanide, dichlorobromomethane, lead, iron, and manganese have been removed, because the discharge does not demonstrate reasonable potential to cause or contribute to an instream exceedance of the applicable water quality objectives. The proposed permit includes effluent limitations for arsenic, nitrate plus nitrite, and zinc that the Facility cannot immediately comply. Therefore, a Time Schedule Order is also proposed allowing a time schedule for the Discharger to comply with these effluent limitations.

The proposed Waste Discharge Requirements for reclamation activities are essentially the same as found in Order R5-2010-0099, except for minor changes to the monitoring requirements and updates related to recent upgrades to the Facility.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **19 October 2015**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments to the Central Valley Water Board via email to RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov no later than 5:00 p.m. on 19 October 2015. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on 19 October 2015 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
