Notice of Intent to Adopt Proposed General Order of Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges Related to Timberland Management Activities (General Order)

Order R5-2010-0022, the existing Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges Related to Timber Harvesting Activities (Waiver), is scheduled to expire on March 31, 2018. Staff proposes to replace the Waiver with the proposed General Order and to present said order for Central Valley Water Board consideration at the board's regular meeting on **June 8/9, 2017**. The Central Valley Water Board is seeking public, industry, and agency input on the proposed adoption of the General Order.
