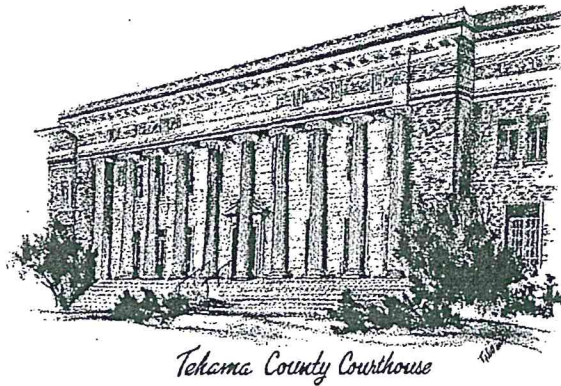


On behalf of the Tehama County Board of Supervisors, I am writing to convey our support for the goals and objectives contained in the recently developed Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (the "State Policy") developed by the State Water Resources Control Board.

In response to the State Policy, the County of Tehama, by and through its Department of Environmental Health, developed a Tier 2 LAMP which consists of Chapter 9.22 of the Tehama County Code (Tehama County Onsite Sewage Disposal Code) and the Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Policy Implementation Plan, which must be approved by the California State Water Resources Control Board.

While the State Policy potentially requires revision of wastewater treatment policies of local Environmental Health jurisdictions throughout California, it is notable that the Tehama County Code Chapter 9.22 (Ordinance No. 1351), revised and codified by the Board of Supervisors in 1986, meets the requirements of the State Policy and that no revisions of the Tehama County Code are needed. Additionally, the Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Policy Implementation Plan provides guidance to implement Chapter 9.22. Together, Chapter 9.22 of the Tehama County Code and the Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Policy Implementation Plan form the LAMP which allows the Department of Environmental Health to continue to allow specially designed systems where needed, allowing smaller lots to be developed, replace systems on substandard lots with failing systems, and provide annual reports to state data bases.

This letter is sent to memorialize the Tehama County Board of Supervisors' adoption of Chapter 9.22 of the Tehama County Code and the Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Policy Implementation Plan as the LAMP.
