TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY OF TEHAMA AND CITY OF RED BLUFF, CLASS III MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL, TEHAMA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and a Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Tehama County / City of Red Bluff, Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, near the community of Red Bluff, Tehama County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 29 April 2017**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 29 April 2017** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 8/9 June 2017 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. By **31 March 2017** post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **5 April 2017**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at:
