TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE & PELORIA MARINAS, LLC, DBA DIGGER BAY MARINA, WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, SHASTA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has prepared tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service & Peloria Marinas, LLC, dba Digger Bay Marina. The Central Valley Water Board is currently soliciting public comments on the tentative WDRs in accordance with the Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements, which is attached to this letter.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements at its **8/9 June 2017** Board Meeting. For your facility to be included with the adopted orders, you must post the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing by **7 April 2017** at the following locations:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the facility (if allowed).

To verify the Notice of Public Hearing has been posted, a completed copy of the enclosed Proof of Posting form must be sent to our office by **14 April 2017**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative WDRs to the Dischargers only. All other persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at:
