

ACQUISITION STATUS - APRIL 1, 2017





- - - - - USACE Project Boundary


LERRDs - Cost In Million\$

REQUESTS TO THE WQCB

- **Assist in procuring funding for the County to meet the TMDL requirements.**
- **Submit, upon request, a letter of support to the California Department of Water Resources Central Valley Tributaries Program in support of the County's upcoming grant application for the project.**
- **Submit, upon request, a letter to the Army Corps of Engineers urging them to expedite the project.**
- **Submit, upon request, letters to Congressman John Garamendi and Senators Feinstein and Harris in support of Congressional funding for the project.**
- **Share ideas with the County on actions to take to help get the project completed.**
