Enclosed are the tentative revised Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Blue Hills Disposal Facility. Also enclosed is a Notice of Public Hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to §2592 of Chapter 15, California Code of Regulations. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs. Revised Monitoring & Reporting Program 99-087 (MRP) was issued on 11 December 2020 and is incorporated into the WDRs as an attachment. No additional revisions or changes were made to the MRP.

Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative WDRs should be submitted to this office in writing by 5:00 p.m. on **20 May 2021** in order that consideration may be given them prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Water Board.
