Broadbent & Associates, Inc. (Broadbent) has prepared this letter providing comments associated with review of the Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements permit associated with wastewater operations at Pilot Travel Center #168 in Dunnigan, Yolo County, California (Site or PTC 168).

[TENTATIVE] WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2022-####

Introduction Item #3 (pdf page 8)

The Facility does not meet the conditions of WQ 2014-0153-DWQ because the Facility receives wash water generated by activities conducted at the former truck wash facility maintenance bays.

Comment: The truck wash has been converted into a truck care facility and all washing equipment has been removed. Wash water has not been discharged as wastewater since conversion in 2018.

Existing Facility and Discharge #11 (pdf page 9)

Wastewater from the travel center and stand-alone restaurant is pumped through a metering station and can be discharged into any one of the five ponds.

Comment: Wastewater from the travel center and stand-alone restaurant are pumped through separate metering stations prior to combined discharge into any one of the five ponds.

Existing Facility and Discharge #15 (pdf page 11)

WSW is the primary source water, which is approximately 520 ft deep and sealed to a depth of 200 ft below ground surface (bgs).

Comment: Well construction details should be reviewed for the WSW and TWW.

Existing Facility and Discharge #17 (pdf page 12)

Wastewater is primarily domestic waste from commercial sources, including kitchen waste and nondomestic flows from the truck service maintenance bay.

Comment: The majority of flow from the truck care facility are domestic waste from the toilet and sink.

Compliance History #21 (pdf page 13)

Comment: No further action has been granted for the Site's environmental case.
