Response to Written Comments for TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RIO VISTA CLASS III LANDFILL CLOSURE, POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE, AND CORRECTIVE ACTION

At a public hearing scheduled for 13/14 October 2022, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of new Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the closed Rio Vista Landfill (Facility) in Solano County. The City of Rio Vista (Discharger) owns and operates the Facility.

The Central Valley Water Board did not receive written comments regarding the tentative WDRs circulated on 3 August 2022. Written comments were required by public notice to be received by the Central Valley Water Board by 2 September 2022 to receive full consideration.

Central Valley Water Board staff made minor changes to the tentative WDRs to improve clarity and fix typographical errors.
