The City of Folsom (City) received a copy of the tentative rescission of waste discharge requirements (WDR) for the Folsom Corporation yard Former Landfill. The tentative rescission recognizes the successful completion of clean closure for the former landfill, thus eliminating the need for further post-closure maintenance or monitoring. The City agrees that this removes the former landfill from being subject to the State Water Board promulgated requirements of Title 27 (Title 27, Section 20950(2)(B)).
