Hello Elizabeth,

After reviewing, Patrick had the following comments: Our review of the tentative WDRs did not reveal any substantive issues, with the exception of G.3. on page 37, which stipulates that “All technical reports submitted under this Order shall be prepared by, or under direction supervision of, a California-licensed civil engineer or engineering geologist.” (emphasis added). This requirement would preclude PG’s from preparing technical reports, which are generally allowed under our license. We see no need or reason for this restriction, and it is not a typical requirement of other WDRs.

I would also like to point out a typo of the word “Demolition” in the glossary on page iv.
