NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING concerning

TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR MA-RU HOLDING COMPANY, INC. AND BONZI SANITATION LANDFILL, GENERAL PARTNERSHIP BONZI SANITATION LANDFILL STANISLAUS COUNTY

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) are tentatively being issued to Ma-Ru Holding Company, Inc. and Bonzi Sanitation Landfill, General Partnership (collectively, Discharger) for Bonzi Sanitation Landfill(Facility) located at 2650 West Hatch Road, approximately three miles southwest of Modesto in Stanislaus County.

The Facility is situated on approximately 156-acre property comprised of Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 017-041-036 and 017-041-042. Four closed waste management units comprise approximately 115 permitted acres of the 156-acre site. The remaining 41 acres contain a groundwater treatment system, a landfill gas extraction system including a flare, a treated groundwater retention basin, the former scale house area, perimeter roads, and two stormwater basins. Also included in the remaining 41 acres is a land application area used by the Facility's groundwater treatment system to beneficially reuse treated groundwater to irrigate agricultural and/or tree crops.

The revision of the current WDRs Order R5-2007-0148 is necessary since the Facility has undergone numerous changes since 2007 including closure of the Facility which involved final closure of all waste management units. The tentative WDRs require the Discharger to continue to fund and perform postclosure maintenance of the facility as well as any corrective action measures necessary to protect the beneficial uses of water.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **16 March 2023**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The Tentative Permit was issued for a 30-day public comment period on **13 February 2023** and comments are due by **5:00 p.m.** on **16 March 2023**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m.** on **16 March 2023** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any person requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
