NOTICE OF TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER FOR CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE ROUTE 120/MCKINLEY INTERCHANGE PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order (Order) for the California Department of Transportation (Permittee), State Route 120/McKinley Interchange Project (Project) in San Joaquin County. The 109-acre Project will construct a new interchange on SR-120 at McKinley Avenue and provide improvements to McKinley Avenue and SR-120. The interchange will be a spread diamond interchange that includes westbound and eastbound on- and off-ramps. Improvements include developing seven lanes under SR-120, and addition of turning lanes, and a bike lane/pedestrian walkway.
