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TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. 87-031; BAPTIST SUGAR PINE CONFERENCE; CAMP SUGAR PINE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM; MADERA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order 87-031 for Baptist Sugar Pine Conference, Camp Sugar Pine Wastewater Treatment Facility (Facility) in Madera County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 15/16 October 2020 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by **5 p.m. on 3 September 2020**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
