**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**CONCERNING**

**RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2012-0083**

**AND**

**TIME SCHEDULE ORDERS R5-2017-0092 AND R5-2017-0092-01**

**FOR**

**CITY OF BIGGS  
BIGGS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
BUTTE COUNTY**

The City of Biggs (hereinafter Discharger) Biggs Wastewater Treatment Plant (hereinafter Facility), located in Butte County, is regulated pursuant to the following Orders: Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order R5-2020-0008, adopted by the Central Valley Water Board on 20 February 2020; WDRs Order R5-2012-0083 (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0078930), adopted by the Central Valley Water Board on 4 October 2012; and TSO R5-2017-0092, adopted by the Central Valley Water Board on 11 August 2017 and amended on 26 November 2019 to become TSO R5-2017-0092-01.

The Discharger has updated processes at the Facility and no longer discharges to surface water. Modifications at the Facility were split into two phases. Phase 1 modifications included upgrades to the headworks and SCADA system. Phase 2 modifications included installation of 6 groundwater monitoring wells, construction of 2-40 million gallon clay lined storage ponds, installation of piping to the clay lined ponds, and acquisition of land for final disposal of treated wastewater. The Discharger no longer discharges to surface water and instead discharges to land pursuant to WDRs Order R5-2020-0008, therefore WDRs Order R5-2012-0083 is no longer applicable. The Discharger completed all requirements for TSO R5-2017-0092 and TSO R5-2017-0092-01. Therefore, TSOs R5-2017-0092 and R5-2017-0092-01 are no longer applicable. Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 20 September 2020**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board email at [RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov](mailto:RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov) no later than **5:00 p.m. on 20 September 2020**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 20 September 2020** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Board Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
