**TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:**

Enclosed is the tentative Time Schedule Order for the City of Galt (Discharger), Wastewater Treatment Plant and Reclamation Facility (Facility). Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order should be submitted to this office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **21 November 2020** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board). Written material submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **21 November 2020** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

If substantial written comments are not received by **21 November 2020**, the Executive Officer will issue the Order after the close of the comment period, in accordance with Central Valley Water Board Resolution R5-2018-0057, which delegates the authority to the Executive Officer to issue or modify time schedule orders.

Any member of the public may request an oral hearing before the Executive Officer. If no oral hearing is requested, the public comment period, and the Executive Officer's review

of the administrative record, including any written comments, shall constitute the public hearing. (See Water Code section 13385, subdivision (j)(3)(C)(ii)(II).) Based on comments received, the Executive Officer may decide to hold an oral hearing or the matter will be considered at the Central Valley Water Board meeting scheduled for 10/11 December 2020.

A Notice of Public Hearing (Notice) concerning the proposed Order is also enclosed. Regulations require that the Discharger post one (1) copy of the Notice at the nearest city hall or county courthouse, one (1) copy at the post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and one (1) copy at the public entrance to the Facility. Please post the Notice as soon as possible and submit proof of posting, using the enclosed form, to this office by **5 November 2020**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative Order package to the Discharger only.
